



...from The Greenhouse Window

There are a number of methods possible for re-creating this pattern:

1. Appliqué – hand or machine
2. Piecing – hand or machine
3. Or both --- choose those techniques with which you are comfortable

The instructions follow the recommended order of assembly.

Assemble the Background:

Piece the *Wall*, *Upper Floor*, *Rug* and *Lower Floor* in the following order using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Press the seam allowances as follows:

	<u>Piece</u>	<u>Press</u>
1.	<i>Wall-Upper Floor</i>	Both toward <i>Upper Floor</i>
2.	<i>Upper Floor-Rug</i>	Both to <i>Rug</i>
3.	<i>Rug-Lower Floor</i>	Both to <i>Rug</i>

Tablecloth & Accessories:

Using the full cartoon and a light table (see *Optional Tools*), place the *Tablecloth* on the background:

- Line up the left edge with the background's left edge
- Remember to allow for the extra $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance at top, bottom & right side

Appliqué the *Tablecloth* in place.

Shadow in the Folds, Table Edge & Tablecloth outline (see Tips):

With the pattern as a guide & a gray dye marker,

1. "Float" a shadow up from the center of each concave curve at the bottom of the tablecloth.
2. Create a stencil using the *Table Edge* pattern; iron in place. Lightly "float" a shadow along the concave curve of the table's edge; remove the freezer paper stencil.
